

BRASS SINKS - Untreated

Due to the intrinsic nature of our handcrafted product and artisan process, variations in dimensions, color, texture, hue, hammering, uniformity, and finishes are expected and not considered defects. The warranty covers what is considered a manufacturer's defect only. Manufacturer's defects include improper welding or structural defects. We offer no warranty with respect to the finish on the products, as the finish naturally changes over time.

Our brass products require special care & maintenance. Be aware that by using products other than the recommended care products or failing to abide by the preventative maintenance measures outlined in the care and maintenance section will void the warranty. Be aware that leaving acidic foods, chemicals, cleaning products, personal grooming products etc. can and will effect the patina of your product. **For this reason, we strongly recommended that you use a superior quality carnauba paste wax to seal the finish BEFORE INITIAL USE.** We also recommend repeating this process **every 6 months** in order to further protect the living finish.

Our brass sinks have a living finish. In other words, the finish will patina over time and develop its own unique character. This finish is not guaranteed for the life of the sink. The finish will however last a very long time with careful care and preventative maintenance. Your sink can and will be directly affected by environmental and personal maintenance factors. Factors include, water quality, air temperature and personal care products. The use of brass polishing agents will remove the patina and restore the metal to its original shine. Once removed, the patina will naturally redevelop with time and use.

TO CLEAN YOUR PRODUCT:

(Daily cleaning) Wash gently with a soft damp cloth. Use soap that is mild and free of anti-bacterial properties that may contain bleach. The original Dawn® soap is a good choice for its neutrality. Apply a small amount of soap to the damp cloth and gently clean the surface. Rinse thoroughly and hand dry. Never use steel wool or a scouring pad or sponge to clean the surface. The use of any cleaners or disinfectants other than mild soap and water will void the warranty.

Please Note! Personal care and everyday use products such as face cleansers, toothpaste, male grooming products, wine, fruit acid, and ketchup can and will alter the finish so **please rinse thoroughly** after exposure to the aforementioned products.

BRASS SINKS - Lacquered

Brass sinks with an indicated lacquered finish will not change and not patina.

We still recommend using a high quality carnauba wax like Flitz without a polishing agent so it will protect the sinks finish.

TO CLEAN YOUR PRODUCT:

Daily use should be a simple rinse with water and wipe with a soft cloth. No abrasives should be used on the sink nor any polish. Mild and pH Neutral soap is preferable, or regular household cleaner without bleach is recommended for cleaning.
